RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the Municipal Solicitor be directed to obtain a Court Injunction in the B.C. Supreme Court to prohibit dumping at 3822 Marine Drive - Lot 148, S½ of S.W.¼, D.L. 175, Plan 24352.


R E P O R T

From time to time both the Health Department and the Engineering Department have requested and directed the owner of the subject property to cease and desist from dumping on the subject property. These instructions have been both verbal and in writing.

Recently, the Engineering Department instructed the truckers working for owner to refrain from dumping and left messages for the owner to the same effect. The dumping did not cease. The Engineering Department then took the matter to the Municipal Solicitor and requested he obtain a court injunction to prohibit dumping. The Municipal Solicitor had letters hand-delivered to the owner to cease and desist.

In spite of these letters, the dumping has continued. The Municipal Solicitor suggested, therefore, that permission be requested from Council to obtain a court injunction.

The material being dumped contains objectionable elements and has the neighbourhood complaining.
