COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The month of January recorded a rash of eighteen incidents of armed robbery of various types. One of these involved two males and a female being charged after robbery of a pharmacy, where a shotgun and knife were used as weapons. Narcotics and approximately \$1,000 in cash were involved. A total of five were solved, with the remainder continuing under investigation.
