and at the Inaugural Meeting of Council on 1978 December 04, Mr. Gordon Mackie was appointed to represent the citizens at large.

At first glance, it would appear that a good cross-section of the community is represented in matters concerning traffic safety. However, I have had a discussion with the British Columbia Old Age Pensioners' Organization representative and it would seem that our objective should be that senior citizens have representation on the Burnaby Traffic Safety Committee to properly deal with traffic safety matters directly affecting that large segment of our community.

Mr. William Anderson, of 1108-5560 Inman Avenue, Burnaby, B.C. V5H 2L9, has been appointed by the Burnaby/New Westminster Regional Area of the B.C. Old Age Pensioners' Organization to make representations concerning matters of safety and other subjects affecting pensioners and senior citizens.

To meet the objective noted herein, I recommend the appointment of Mr. William Anderson as "Senior Citizen Representative" to the Traffic Safety Committee, and that a similar appointment to represent our seniors be made annually when Committee Appointments are made.
