RECOMMENDATIONS

1. THAT the S.P.C.A. continue to provide the services of poundkeeper on a month to month basis until 1982 March 31, under the terms and conditions of the 1981 contract provided, however, that the rate to be negotiated for services to be performed in 1982 shall be retroactive to 1982 January 01; and

REPORT

Council on 1981 December 14 resolved to continue the 1981 contract with the S.P.C.A. to provide poundkeeping services on a monthly basis to 1982 January 31, provided that the rate to be negotiated for services to be performed in 1982 would be retroactive to 1982 January 01. This action was in response to a request from the S.P.C.A. because negotiations for a working agreement with their employees were in progress and they were unable to estimate costs for 1982.

The Society advises that negotiations are still continuing and they have requested an extension of the existing arrangement to 1982 February 28.

In the event that negotiations are not concluded by the above date, and in order to allow staff time to review and prepare an analysis of the proposal which will be received from the S.P.C.A. upon conclusion of negotiations, it is recommended that the month to month arrangement be approved to 1982 March 31.
