THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURBARY

TO: MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
RE: STATUTORY INAUGURAL MEETINGS

MADAM AND GENTLEMEN:

Council will recall the motion passed on 1982 November 22 as follows:

"THAT there be no extra activities other than what is called for at the Statutory Inaugural Meeting, with invitations to be mailed out and coffee and tea to be provided."

Also under New Business on 1980 December 08 the following motion was passed:

- "- In election off years have light refreshments.
- For all Inaugural meetings invite those to attend who are up for appointment.
- No regular Council business be conducted during the off year Inaugural meeting."

The motion put at the Council meeting of 1982 November 22 restricts the business that can be conducted and the refreshments served for all inaugural meetings. I would therefore recommend the following policy:

1. THAT at all Inaugural Meetings light refreshments will be served, unless otherwise directed by Council.
2. THAT for all Inaugural Meetings those who are up for appointments shall be invited.
3. THAT only emergent Council business be conducted at Inaugural Meetings.
