Madam and Gentlemen:


Council will recall on 1982 May 17, authorization was given for an amount of money to be expended for the purpose of holding a reception in honour of visitors from our Sister City, Kushiro.

The visitors were members of Kushiro Junior Chamber of Commerce/Kushiro Karate Club. They were hosted by Burnaby Junior Chamber of Commerce and the B.C. Karate Club. Our gracious guests were most appreciative of all that was done for them and will take back with them very warm thoughts of Burnaby and our citizens.

Since the relationship between Kushiro and Burnaby seems to be growing and obviously there will be many exchange visits in the future, both formal and informal, I would make the following recommendations:

- (1) That Council consider opening a permanent "Kushiro Budget Account" in the amount of \$2,000. so that monies are available for any contingencies that may arise with regard to unanticipated visits from our Sister City citizens; and
- (2) That Council formally appoint the Mayor while he or she is in office as the Chairman of our Sister City Committee with power to co-opt members as necessary.
