REPORT OF THE POLLUTION COMMITTEE

1. 4163 Sardis Street - Sanitary Sewer Connection

Recommendation:

"That the owner of the property at 4163 Sardis Street be granted an extension of time until 1982 December 31, for connection of the property to the sanitary sewer system subject to approval of the septic tank system by the Chief Public Health Inspector."

R E P O R T

The Director Engineering prepared a report with respect to the status of the sanitary sewer system at 4163 Sardis Street which reads as follows:

"The owner of the above mentioned property on 1980 December 08 was granted an extension to 1981 December 31. We have received a letter from Claymore Developments on behalf of the property owner requesting a further extension to 1982 December 31 pending development of the Metrotown Area 2 plan.

Inspection of the premises by the Environmental Health Department reveals the septic tank to be functioning adequately at this time."

2. 3767 Thurston Street - Sanitary Sewer Connection

Recommendation:

"That the owner of the property at 3767 Thurston Street be granted an extension of time until 1982 December 31, for connection of the property to the sanitary sewer system subject to the approval of the septic tank system by the Chief Public Health Inspector."

R E P O R T

The Director Engineering prepared a report with respect to the status of the sanitary sewer system at 3767 Thurston Street which reads as follows:

"The owner of the property at 3767 Thurston Street on 1980 December 08 was granted an extension by Council to 1981 May 01 for connection of the property to the sanitary sewer. The property had been disconnected from the sewer and reconnected to the septic tank by the previous owner.

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Following the civic strike, the owner was advised that the period granted for extension had expired and connection to the sanitary sewer must now be made. Mr. Mesini now requests an extension to 1982 December. He sites physical and financial hardship and the proposed redevelopment of the Metrotown Area 2 plan.

It has been determined the basement plumbing installed without permit or inspection cannot be served by the sanitary sewer.

It is assumed that the previous owner was aware of this condition and therefore reconnected the premises to the septic tank after installing the basement fixtures."


