RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT a frontage tax by-law be brought down to impose a local improvement frontage tax on the projects listed in Schedules 1 to 18 of this report.

REPORT

Annually it is necessary to pass a by-law to impose frontage taxes for local improvement works. Generally, the by-law covers those works which were completed in 1981 or which will be substantially completed by 1982 June 01. The first billing will appear on the 1982 tax statement. Details of the works are shown on the schedules. Following is a summary of the works involved:
