REPORT:

This request is similar to previous requests which have been received and permission granted. We are not aware of any complaints as a result of other events from either the public or the R.C.M.P. Therefore, we see no objections to this proposed event if the same conditions are met. These conditions are:

1. That the Association accept all responsibility to ensure the safety of both the participants and the public along the approved route for the duration of the race, and
2. That the race organizer provide all marshalls and warning signs as indicated in their application.

The R.C.M.P. were consulted and concur with the conditions set forth and the recommendations of the Director Engineering.

Due to the increasing development and growth in traffic volumes this Department feels that events of this nature will not be allowed within the Lake City Industrial Park after 1982. We are prepared to discuss alternative locations to hold future events similar to the captioned event at the request of the applicant.
