2. THAT Council authorize the preparation of the necessary By-Law for the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities.


REPORT

At its meeting of 1982 January 20 the Parks & Recreation Commission received a report requesting that the remaining funds in the reserve account for capital improvement at Barnet Marine Park be expended on the continuation of the reclamation of the salt water frontage. The program is occurring in the area west of Texaco.

All the permits are in order for continuing the work with an abundance of select free material being available from the private sector. The only cost to the Corporation to this point has been site supervision and the cost of a machine and operator required to place the materials. This is being done as per the consultants specifications.

It is anticipated this \$56,757 will be sufficient to look after the aforementioned through 1982.

The Commission approved the expenditure of the funds and requests Council authority for the necessary By-Law.
