REPORT

On 1982 May 17, Council received letters from Shirley W. North, R.N., and Jean E. Leier with reference to provisions for in-law suite accommodation in duplex and semi-detached dwellings. As noted on the letter received from Ms. Leier, 59 identical letters were submitted by residents of the same general area of South Burnaby.

At that Council meeting, Council adopted the recommendation of the Housing Committee that the Burnaby Zoning By-Law be amended to provide for in-law suite accommodation in the Residential District R9 and also in two-family dwellings in the R4 and R5 Districts.
