SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council adopt the following resolution:-

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, pursuant to the power vested in it by Section 29 of the Police Act being chapter 331 of R.S.B.C. 1979, does hereby appoint as Bylaw Enforcement Officers in and for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby the following persons, namely,

ROBERT GERALD MCLEAN  
EDWARD KENNETH MUNDI  
JOHN ALAN GOLAT  
ROBERT IAN SIMPSON

who shall, under the direction of the Officer In Charge of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Burnaby Detachment, enforce the bylaws of the municipality, and for that purpose have all the powers and immunities contained in any of the said Bylaws or otherwise within the power of this Council to bestow.

REPORT

The RCMP have brought to our attention the lack of an official appointment of our Bylaw Enforcement Officers under Section 29 of the Police Act which reads as follows:

- "29. (1) Bylaw enforcement officers may be appointed,  
(a) by a board; or  
(b) where there is no board in a municipality, by the municipal council.
- (2) A bylaw enforcement officer shall be paid the remuneration and shall be appointed for the term that the board or municipal council, as the case may be, determines.
- (3) A bylaw enforcement officer shall, under the direction of the chief constable or officer in charge of the detachment of police operating in the municipality, perform the functions and duties, and have the powers and immunities, respecting the enforcement of municipal bylaws, that the board or municipal council, as the case may be, specifies in the appointment."

The appointments can be made by a resolution of council.
