

REPORT

The existing Management Agreement between the Corporation of the District of Burnaby and Century Park Museum Association, for the management of Heritage Village Museum expires 1982 November 30. As you are aware, I have been working over the past several months with the Museum Director and the Museum Board in reviewing the existing agreement, and preparing proposals for a new and revised agreement.

Please be advised that the Board considered a revised draft agreement at its meeting of 1982 November 23, and determined that a number of clauses in the agreement required further discussion. I have advised the Board that, while the existing agreement expires shortly, that I did not foresee any problem with finalizing the new agreement sometime in December or January.

I expect to be meeting again with the Committee of the Board and the Museum Director in the very near future, to finalize those points in the agreement which are not yet expressed in mutually accepted language. I would hope that the agreement, with CPMA Board approval, should be before Council for its consideration and approval not later than early January.
