
1. THAT Council give advance approval to the following Capital expenditures from the Recreation & Cultural Services' 1982 Provisional Budget:
 - a) Installation of lawn bowling and security lights at Central Park - \$11,000
 - b) Relocation of adult softball backstop at Suncrest Park - \$5,000.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1982 March 03 the Parks & Recreation Commission approved advance expenditures from the 1982 Recreation & Cultural Services' C.I.P. for construction projects at Central Park and Suncrest Park.

The Central Park project, in the amount of \$11,000, is to provide lawn bowling and security lights for the South Burnaby Lawn Bowling Club. The Club has advised staff that its opening date is 1982 April 24 and that intended celebrations would include the new lighting system on their greens.

The Suncrest Park project, in the amount of \$5,000, is to relocate the softball backstop. The work is to be completed by the end of April so that the field can be allocated for the 1982 softball season.
