SUMMARY

It was brought to attention during Council enquiries that there was rowdyism, vandalism, etc. attributed to B.C.I.T. students living in the Brentwood House on Halifax Street, by way of shouting from balconies, dropping beer bottles onto the street, etc. This occurred during April and again during the first week of June. Mr. RAVEY asked for some action by the Municipality in conjunction with the school officials.


REPORT

The police attended to a complaint call on the evening of 83 JUN 03. Lack of identification prevented any consideration toward the laying of criminal charges. Some students were spoken to and made aware of future expectations. Those students were from outside the Lower Mainland attending classes for a limited duration.

The initial reference was made to this being students from B.C.I.T. However, it should be clarified this refers to the Pacific Vocational Institute (P.V.I.) under the auspices of the Minister of Labour. Mr. HARVIE, Chief Public Health Inspector, has stated he has contacted the management of the building to be followed by a letter outlining the complaint and concern.

Our investigator met with Mr. RAVEY to discuss the concern he identified. He was encouraged to call in again should the situation repeat itself and we would need to deal with it on site and, if necessary, review further followup action. The classes are apparently terminated for the summer.

Copy has been provided direct to the Chief Public Health Inspector.
