Coconut Theatre Society

For the information of Council, your Committee would advise that the Coconut Theatre Society is a non-profit society. Their objective is to create and produce historical and special cultural events theatre. Last summer, they produced "Gold Rush and Fire" at the Heritage Village Museum. Next year, they plan to produce a play in the same style but on the theme of "rivers, lakes and ocean - how they opened up the Province and influenced the lifestyle of the pioneers".

The request is for funding to hire two Burnaby students for eleven weeks in the summer of 1984. This would provide the students with experience in ticket sales, stage management, stage lighting and some book-keeping. The amount requested is \$2,750.

Your Committee has no alternative but to recommend to Council that this application be denied as the request does not meet the criteria contained in our policy and guidelines, i.e. "A contribution can be given for start-up funding towards overhead costs, but not for salaries or wages."
