RECOMMENDATION

1. THAT the S.P.C.A. continue to provide the services of a poundkeeper on a month to month basis until 1984 February 29, under the terms and conditions of the 1983 contract provided, however, that the rate to be negotiated for services to be performed in 1984 shall be retroactive to 1984 January 01.

REPORT

The contract with the S.P.C.A. in which they were appointed poundkeeper for the Municipality expires on 1983 December 31.

The Society proposes to continue to provide poundkeeping services on a monthly basis under the terms and conditions of the 1983 contract provided that the rate to be negotiated for services to be performed in 1984 would be retroactive to 1984 January 01.

This arrangement is being proposed because they are finalizing negotiations with their employees for a working agreement and they are unable to estimate final costs for 1984. Negotiations are expected to be finalized by the end of January 1984.

In order to allow staff time to review and prepare an analysis of the contract proposal which will be forthcoming from the S.P.C.A., it is recommended that a month to month agreement be approved to 1984 February 29.
