RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the preliminary outline of goals, objectives, and performance measurements that is attached to Item 5, Report No. 72 dated 1983 November 28 be adopted as the basis for periodic reporting to Council

EXCEPT THAT

the fundamental goal related to the Natural and Physical Environment Element be amended to read as follows:

"To preserve the balance between developed and natural areas by the conservation and enhancement of the unique attributes of the landscape, the minimization of environmental pollution and the use of accepted urban design principles to ensure that new structures are appropriately related to their surroundings".

R E P O R T

During its consideration of Item 5, Manager's Report No. 72, Council meeting 1983 November 28, Council requested staff to reconsider the wording associated with the fundamental goal for the Natural and Physical Environment Element. This action resulted from a concern that the wording as related to the development of new structures being compatible with the natural environment could be too restrictive, if taken literally. To overcome this, it is recommended that the fundamental goal as related to the Natural and Physical Environment Element be amended from:

to read as follows:

"To preserve the balance between developed and natural areas by the conservation and enhancement of the unique attributes of the landscape, the minimization of environmental pollution and the use of *accepted urban design principles to ensure that new structures are appropriately related to their surroundings.*"

That portion of the fundamental goal that has been amended is shown in italics.
