RECOMMENDATION:

REPORT

In April and May of this year, Council considered reports from the Sign Bylaw Review Committee of Council and the Municipal Manager, and gave approval to a number of proposals to amend the Burnaby Sign Bylaw. The Municipal Solicitor was directed to prepare the necessary text amendments to effect the changes, with the understanding that members of Council would be given an opportunity to examine the language of the proposed amendments prior to the bylaw being presented on the agenda for Readings.

The text of the amendments has now been received from the Solicitor's office, reflecting the intent of the various amendments as approved by Council. Additional clarifying adjustments and amendments to keep the bylaw current have been introduced only as housekeeping items where needed.

Copies of the text in the amending bylaw form in which it is to be presented are submitted for Council members' information under separate cover. Additional copies will be available in the Municipal Clerk's office for anyone interested in the actual text.

The amending bylaw is intended to be placed before Council for First, Second and Third Readings at the 1983 October 31 meeting.
