REPORT


At its meeting of 1983 June 15 the Parks and Recreation Commission was advised of the following:

In recent months it has been observed that there has been a considerable increase in problems on Park sites which are associated with the illegal consumption of alcohol. There have been increased complaints from park users and particularly from neighbouring residents regarding noisy and anti-social behaviour on the part of patrons taking part in sporting activities and sometimes picnic events.

Municipal staff and R.C.M.P. have devoted considerable time to working with sports and picnic organizers within the enforcement procedures in an attempt to eliminate this problem. The results have not been good and the problem continues to worsen.

It is therefore the intention of the staff and the R.C.M.P. to move to a much stricter enforcement procedure commencing in the near future.

The organizers of sporting events have been so advised and picnic organizers are advised at the time allotments are issued.
