SUMMARY:

Notices requiring immediate compliance with the Burnaby Noise or Sound Abatement By-law are being hand-delivered to the tenants at 5292 and 5294 Manor Street, Burnaby, and the registered owner.

Should complaints continue and noise level emission readings be found to be in excess of by-law standards, court action will be taken.

REPORT

Further to receipt of a letter of complaint addressed to the Mayor and Council, regarding excessive and disturbing noise emission from tenants at a four-plex, addressed 5292/5294 Manor Street, Burnaby, we would advise as follows.

The district Public Health Inspector is currently serving notices to the occupants and the registered owner, requiring immediate compliance with the Burnaby Noise or Sound Abatement By-law.

Upon receipt of further complaints, sound level measurements will be conducted and court action taken should the noise level measurements be found to be in excess of the Noise By-law standards.

Insofar as the reference to unsanitary property conditions and rodents, no violation of the Burnaby Unsightly Premises By-law was noted at the time of notice serving.

We have advised Mrs. M. Perko, 5310 Manor Street, of the action taken on the letter of complaint. Mrs. Perko will contact this Division, should further noise disturbances or accumulations of garbage occur. She has been advised of the procedure for contacting the district Public Health Inspector during non-working hours.
