60-16-079

Construct road, drainage, sidewalk, street lighting, and landscaping works by Burnaby Municipal forces on Boundary Road, Kingsway to Imperial Street.

CHARGE: 1983 Capital Budget

Code 16-08 - Major Roads

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This work order is to cover the cost of work carried out by Municipal crews related to the construction of Boundary Road. This includes the cost of shareable and non-shareable items with both the Province and the City of Vancouver. Funds are provided in the 1983 Capital Budget under Major Roads.

60-16-078

Construct road, drainage, and ornamental street lighting works covering Burnaby's share of works constructed by the City of Vancouver or its contractors on Boundary Road, Kingsway to Imperial Street.

CHARGE: 1983 Capital Budget

Code 16-08 - Major Roads

\$465,000

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This work order is to cover Burnaby's share of the cost of construction of Boundary Road between Kingsway and Imperial Street that is shareable with the Province.

This was to be a Revenue Sharing Fund project with the cost shared between the Province (50%), the City of Vancouver (25%), and Burnaby (25%). The original application to the Province was rejected by the Province because of lack of funds. The City of Vancouver (acting as Project Managers), appealed with a request that surplus funds from Revenue Sharing projects in Vancouver be transferred to this project; the Province has now approved of this request by approving transfers in the total amount of \$390,000. This is \$35,000 short of what would normally be full eligible sharing by the Province; application for the remaining \$35,000 will be made for 1984 or it may be possible to

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arrange for transfer of possible surplus Revenue Sharing funds on the Burnaby project (B.N.R.).

Funds for Burnaby's share are provided in the 1983 Capital Budget under Major Roads.

60-70-114

Construct 18 vehicle crossings to serve Municipal lots for sale, Lots 276 - 285 and 287 - 294 inclusive, Glen Abbey Drive.

CHARGE: 1983 Capital Budget

Code 70 - Land Assembly

\$ 6,400

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: It is Corporation policy to construct vehicle crossings at no charge to lots sold by the Corporation in order to fulfill our obligation to sell fully serviced lots. The crossings will be constructed when building plans have been submitted and building permits issued.

Manager's Report No. 59, Item 5, 1983 10 03, advises that the lots described herein will be offered for sale.

Funds are provided in the 1983 Capital Budget.
