R E P O R T

Council at its meeting of 1983 July 11 received a letter from the Century Park Museum Association Board of Directors indicating it was prepared to restore the Hart Mansion if Council provided the necessary funds as well as subsidize its operating costs.

Staff are preparing a report for Council's consideration that will allow it to evaluate the C.P.M.A. Board's proposal and other options. An important aspect of this process is the cost of renovations required to bring the house up to an acceptable standard for a particular use (e.g. Heritage house, interim residential rental purposes). The Engineering and the Planning and Building Inspection Departments are presently undertaking this costing. It is anticipated that the work will be completed for a report to Council at its next meeting on 1983 August 08.
