SUBJECT: OXFORD STREET - ORIGIN STUDY

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT:

At its meeting of 1983 February 21, the Engineering Department was requested to submit a report on the cost of conducting an origin study of traffic on Oxford Street between Willingdon Avenue and Boundary Road.

We would advise that the Engineering Department is presently conducting such a study to obtain data for the street classification study being conducted for the area. This information is being obtained through licence plate checks during the rush hours supplemented by spot checks during non-rush hours.

When we have completed the study, a summation of the results will be contained in the overall report to the Transportation Committee concerning street classifications.

The study is being done by Municipal staff and therefore the costs incurred are already provided for in the Engineering Department Budget as part of normal staff wage costs.
