1. That this report be received for information.


SUMMARY:

1. The report from the Municipal Solicitor made reference to the apprehension of subjects, who had reportedly vandalized the residence. Council asked for further information reference what charges were laid, ages of the individuals and if restitution was ordered.

REPORT

Two juveniles ages 11 and 14 were apprehended after they had left the premises and gone to a nearby store. These juveniles readily admitted to being in the house, where they slept after running away from home. They maintained they found the rear door to the residence open and denied doing any damage. The window in the rear door had been broken which allowed entry via that door. It could not be specifically established that the glass was intact on the day immediately prior to the juveniles being found inside, therefore the matter could not be proceeded with via the courts. Subsequently the question of restitution did not surface.

The two juveniles were diverted to the Youth Services Program for counselling. The concluding report indicates progress was made and previous lack of parent/child communication saw some development. There was nothing to support evidence that any damage was attributed to these two juveniles.
