Phase I of preparation of industrial sites for future development at Marine Way/Greenall Avenue and Roseberry Avenue.

CHARGE: Code 70, Land Assembly  
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: It is opportune to take advantage of the availability from time to time of good quality fill material to preload and raise the elevation of the sites, adhering to site specific recommendations of soils consultants.

To develop possible alternatives to full floodproofing of the Big Bend Area and to prepare an application for possible diking assistance from the Provincial and Federal Governments.

CHARGE: Code 70, Land Assembly  
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: On several occasions, Burnaby has made inquiries about qualifying for assistance under Federal/Provincial Diking legislation and there is still a chance that we could receive approval. The provision of dikes may offer a viable alternative to expensive and time-consuming full elevation floodproofing in the Big Bend Area.

Clearing, rough grading, and ditching on Beaverbrook Drive, Noel Drive to Cameron Street.

CHARGE: Code 16, Major Roads  
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Now is the appropriate time to commence work on the clearing, rough grading, and preliminary drainage control components of the construction of Beaverbrook Drive from Cameron Street to Noel Drive. A further work order will be issued in very early 1984 against the 1984 Capital Budget in order to perform the balance of the total construction of this road link.
