REPORT

The Municipality is the owner of a part 0.133 acre portion of Lot 1 Block "H" of Lot 118 Group 1 Plan 3067 New Westminster District. The Municipality acquired this land by deed dated May 22, 1929. This land is part of Gilmore Avenue at Dawson Street but has never been formally dedicated as highway. The Land Title Office has requested that this be done. The Director Engineering has no objection. Accordingly, Bylaw No. 8019, being Burnaby Highway Dedication Bylaw 1983, has been prepared to dedicate this land as highway, a copy of which is attached.

BYLAW NO. 8019

A BYLAW to dedicate certain municipally-owned lands as highway

The Council of The Corporation of the District of

Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY HIGHWAY DEDICATION

BYLAW 1983.

2. The Council does hereby dedicate as highway those municipally-owned lands more particularly described as follows:

Part (Decimal One Hundred and Thirty-three (0.133))

Of an acre more or less) of Lot One (1) BLOCK "H" of Lot One Hundred and Eighteen (118) Group One (1) Map 3067 lying within the following described boundaries:

COMMENCING at the Special Survey Monument set at the Northeast corner of Lot 1 aforesaid thence North 89° 18' West and following the Northerly Boundary of said Lot 1 33.0 feet to an iron pin thence South 0° 08' 30" West and parallel to the Easterly Boundary of said Lot 1 163.92 feet more or less to an iron pin set on the Southwesterly Boundary of said Lot 1 thence South 54° 23' 30" East and following the said South Westerly Boundary of Lot 1 40.52 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 1 thence North 0° 08' 30" East and following the Easterly Boundary of said Lot 1, 187.11 feet to the point of commencement and as shewn and outlined Red on Sketch deposited No. 6830, in the District of New Westminster.

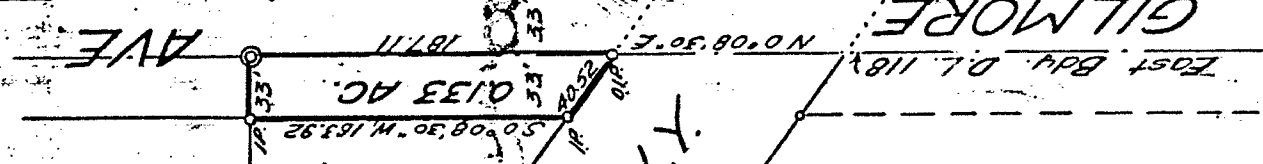
