RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council authorize the use of \$124,000 of Municipal contingency funds to interim finance the Housing Data Base Program until such time as the by-law to appropriate funds is adopted.

REPORT

The Housing Committee at its meeting on 1982 December 20 approved the creation of a Housing Compaction Data Base and has subsequently forwarded that recommendation to Council.

Prior to expending the Municipal Incentive Grant funds it is necessary to receive approval from the Minister of Municipal Affairs of a by-law appropriating the \$124,000 from the Municipal Reserve Account. The Treasurer advises that such approval could take several weeks to obtain. Funds for this work were not included in the 1983 Provisional Budget, but will be in the 1983 Annual Budget.

The Housing Committee has expressed the desire to proceed with this work as quickly as possible.

In order to avoid possible delay due to the procedures associated with adoption of the by-law the Treasurer recommends advancing \$124,000 from contingency until such time as the by-law to appropriate the funds is adopted.

This action would provide funds to commence the work immediately following Council's approval.
