REPORT

Further to receipt of a letter addressed to the Mayor and Council from the Right to Quiet, Society for Soundscape Awareness and Protection, 1431 - 30th Street, West Vancouver, B.C., V7V 4N7, regarding suggestions for amendments to the Burnaby Noise or Sound Abatement By-law, we would advise as follows.

We have discussed with Mr. J.E. Beltz, concerns that society has regarding excessive stereo noise. Mr. Beltz was informed of the Environmental Health Division's program for resolving noise complaints under the authority of the Burnaby Noise or Sound Abatement By-law #7332.

Mr. Beltz was not knowledgeable of any problems that citizens of this municipality were encountering with excessive stereo noise. We have instructed Mr. Beltz to contact this office should the society receive complaints of excessive noise within the municipality or if additional information is required from society members on this Division's noise bylaw enforcement program.
