
Accommodation for the visitors is being provided by "billets" in the homes of Burnaby citizens. Many of the meals and tours on the itinerary have been donated. There will be other incidental expenses involved including the cost of a reception that is presently being arranged at Burnaby Lake Pavilion for Sunday, September 18th (7 p.m.), to which all hosts and guests will be invited as well as Members of Council who, hopefully, will have returned from Penticton in time for this event.

This reception will provide an opportunity to present the "Burnaby Cup" to Professor Makino who will take it back to the Mayor of Kushiro for presentation as an annual award to the "Outstanding Kushiro Citizen of the Year".

As the \$2,000. in the 1983 "Kushiro Budget Account" is almost depleted, it is recommended that the sum of up to \$2,000. be transferred as required to that account from the Grants and Publicity budget to cover the cost of anticipated expenditures for this Sister City visit.
