Recommendation

41. Girl Guides of Canada, Burnaby Royal Area \$1,000.

An application has been received from this organization for a municipal grant in 1983. The last time they received such a grant was in the year 1979 in the amount of \$750.

We are advised that the applicant submitted a similar request in 1982 but your Committee has no record of having received it and therefore no action was taken on the application.

Your Committee feels that this application merits favourable consideration and is recommending that a grant in the amount of \$1,000. be awarded the Burnaby Royal Area Girl Guides for 1983.

45. Burnaby Amateur Radio Club \$5,000.
(for the year 1984)

The Burnaby Amateur Radio Club is closely associated with the Burnaby Major Emergency Planning Committee and plays a major role in the preparations for any major emergency that may occur in Burnaby.

The grant requested is to pay for the additional rent assessed against the Club by the Parks and Recreation Commission for the use of Bonsor Hall. The Club has been paying an annual rental for part of Bonsor in the amount of \$659. This will be increased to \$5,460. for 1984.

Your Committee is satisfied that this Club performs an extremely worthwhile service to the Municipality of Burnaby and therefore unanimously recommends that that a grant of \$5,000. be provided to the Burnaby Amateur Radio Club for the year 1984.
