REPORT OF THE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

1. Traffic Problems in the North Burnaby Area

Recommendations:

- (a) "THAT the Transportation Committee supports the recommendation of the Traffic Safety Committee that the existing stop signs stopping traffic travelling north and south on the avenues intersecting Oxford Street be removed and that stop signs be installed at alternating intersections on Albert and Oxford Streets from Willingdon Avenue to Boundary Road, stopping traffic travelling in an east/west direction on a trial basis.
- (b) THAT the Transportation Committee supports the petition presented by the residents of Oxford Street to the Director Engineering to curb and pave Oxford Street to a maximum width of 28 feet.
- (c) THAT the Transportation Committee be authorized to request the Minister of Transportation and Highways to implement no parking restrictions on both sides of Hastings Street from 07:00h to 09:00 h and from 15:00 h to 18:00 h immediately."
