RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this report be received for information purposes.

REPORT

On 1984 February 27 and 1984 March 19, Council received information reports outlining the Building Inspection Division's progress in enforcement of the Burnaby Sign By-Law with respect to illegally displayed portable signs. Council subsequently passed Burnaby Sign Removal Authorization By-Laws No. 1 and 2 providing for the removal of particular signs where the owners or occupants had failed to remove them following proper notice.

Through ongoing staff involvement, the overall incidence of large illegal portable signs has decreased greatly. A summary of current statistics is provided:

Total number of offending locations recorded	113
Signs voluntarily removed	91
Signs impounded under Removal By-Law No. 1	3
Signs impounded under Street & Traffic By-Law	1
Outstanding signs being processed	9
Signs to be dealt with under Removal By-Law No. 3	<u>9</u>

The Municipal Solicitor is now preparing a third enforcement by-law under Section 735 of the Municipal Act to authorize the removal of 9 outstanding illegal portable signs. This by-law will be presented for first, second and third readings on 1984 June 18, and for final adoption on June 25.
