RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT alignment 1a (Item Supplementary 9, Manager's Report #70, 84/11/05) be approved as the preferred alignment for the eastern terminus of Central Boulevard with Imperial Street.

REPORT

At its meeting of 1984 November 07, the Parks and Recreation Commission considered the two alignments described as 1 and 1a which were included in the Municipal Manager's Report #9 referenced above.


The Commission meeting followed a special meeting at which contingents from Municipal Council, the Parks and Recreation Commission and the South Burnaby Men's Club led by Mayor W. Lewarne, Chairman K. Thorne and Mr. R. Smith respectively had met informally between 6:30 and 7:30 p.m. to discuss the relative merits of the two alignments. The Commission is satisfied that the needs of the South Burnaby Men's Club have been met and that at the informal meeting, the Club contingent supported alignment 1a. The Commission is also satisfied that alignment 1a meets the needs of the Commission in terms of continuing program and sufficient land and parking.
