On 1984 May 07, Manager's Report No. 33, Item 8 was tabled pending information on previous concerns by the neighbourhood regarding the above closure and problems with respect to access during the winter months.

The subject 20 ft. allowance is undeveloped and we have no record of any opposition to the closure at this location.

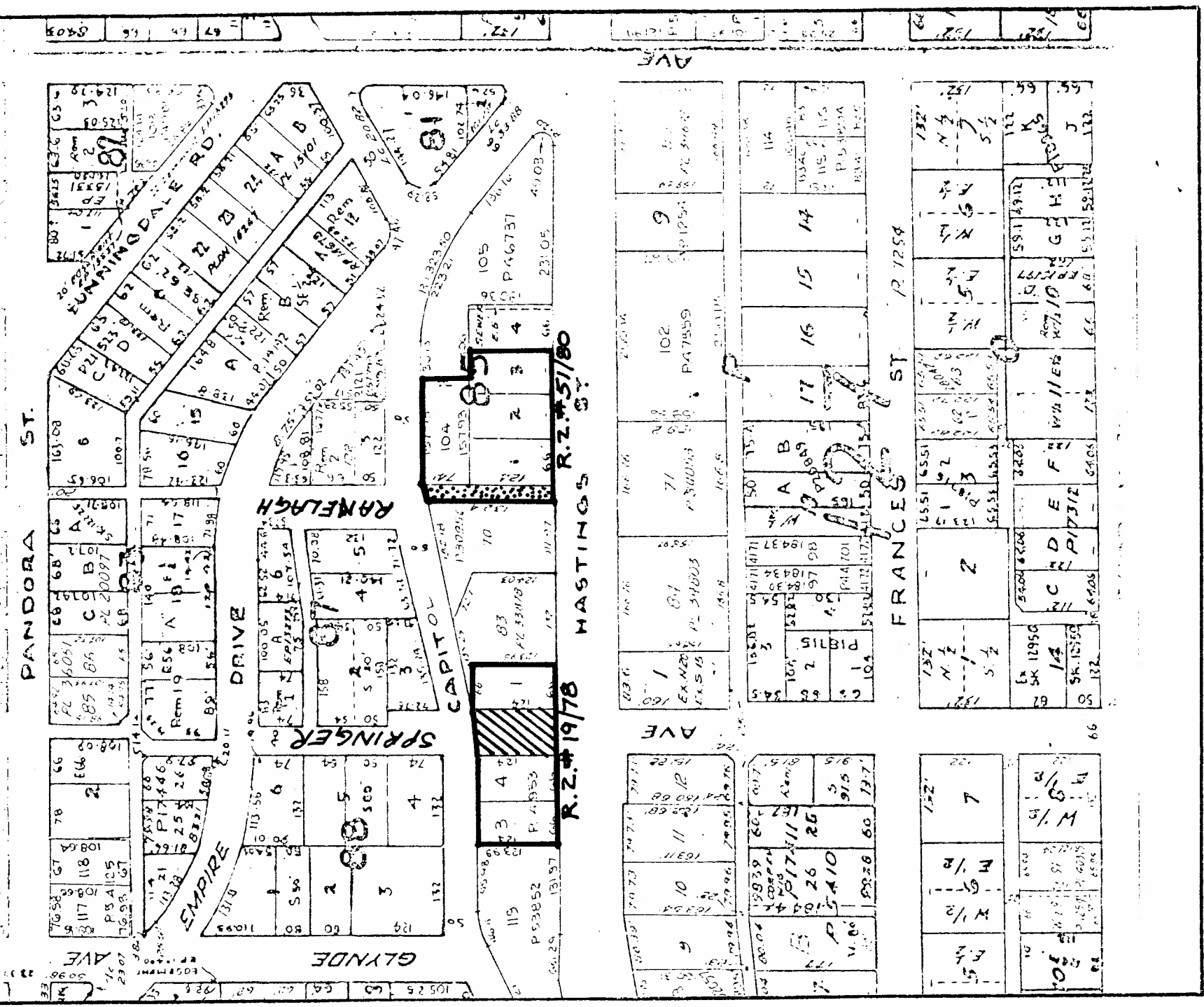
However, the two concerns raised were dealt with under Rezoning Reference #19/78 where closure of Springer Avenue between Hastings and Capitol was proposed (see attached sketch) but opposed at the Public Hearing. This rezoning bylaw was subsequently abandoned on 1978 October 24 since it was the opinion of Council that the proposed closure of Springer Avenue was not practical.
