R E P O R T

On 1984 August 27 Council gave three readings to 'Robert Burnaby Park Boundary Realignment Bylaw, 1984', Bylaw No. 8253. By report on 1984 September 10 Council was advised that the bylaw required the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs. Section 532(3) of the Municipal Act states that the Minister may, before giving his approval to the bylaw, direct that the assent of the electors of the Municipality be obtained.

Staff have now been notified by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs that, in lieu of a vote, it is the Ministry's practice to ensure, before advancing the bylaw to the Minister for approval, that the public be fully informed of the proposal. In accordance with this practice the Ministry has requested that the Municipality place a notice in the newspaper and provide a statement ten (10) days after publication of the notice advising as to whether any objections to the proposal were lodged with the Municipality.

In compliance with direction given by the Ministry the attached advertisement will appear in the next edition of Burnaby Now.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Municipal Council proposes to adopt Bylaw No. 8253 cited as "Robert Burnaby Park Boundary Realignment Bylaw, 1984" which is intended to amend the Robert Burnaby Park boundary in order to provide approximately 396 m² (approx. 4263 sq. ft.) required as a road allowance for the perimeter road of a proposed municipal subdivision, Subdivision Reference No. 63/83. The approximately 396 m² (approx. 4263 sq. ft.) of parkland required for the road allowance will be replaced by an adjacent area of approximately 309 m² (approx. 3326 sq. ft.) which is redundant to the subdivision and is proposed to be added to the parkland.

The proposed Bylaw and Plan referred to herein may be inspected at the office of the Municipal Clerk for a ten day period following the date of the publication of this notice.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that any person who deems themselves affected by the proposed Bylaw may attend at the Burnaby Municipal Hall between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. from Monday to Friday or may send in written notice of any objections addressed to the Municipal Clerk, Corporation of the District of Burnaby, 4949 Canada Way, Burnaby, British Columbia, V5G 1M2.
