Madam and Gentlemen:


The Executive Committee of the Greater Vancouver Regional District met today regarding the responsibility for Criminal Document Servicing.

At this meeting, the following resolution was passed and I would recommend concurrence in the action of this Committee:

"MOVE that we inform the Attorney-General that those municipalities with local forces will direct that their forces not serve criminal processes and those municipalities that have a contract for RCMP services, and which have a limited direct control over their forces, will not increase their policing services to handle the serving of criminal documents nor sanction any reductions in the level of policing service to handle this function;

AND THAT we ask the Attorney-General to respond to our numerous requests for a meeting to discuss the problems and ramifications of his Ministry's actions."
