RE: APPOINTMENTS AND REAPPOINTMENTS


Madam and Gentlemen:

In reviewing the appointments and reappointments for the Inaugural Meeting of Council on 1984 December 03, I have found some inconsistencies of the past. While most boards, commissions and committees have three two-year terms, for a total service of six years as a policy, others do not have this regulation.

To be consistent, appointments to all boards, commissions and committees should be for three two-year terms, for a maximum period of six years, except where legislation precludes this.

I would therefore recommend that all appointments to Council boards, commissions and committees be for three two-year terms for a maximum of six years, except where legislation precludes this.
