2. Occasionally this problem is noticed in the area of Gilmore/Lougheed/Willingdon, but not prominent north of there.
3. The patrols will continue to monitor the situation. The speeding of vehicles in the area is an ongoing enforcement activity and hopefully the presence of the police in the area, as time permits, will have a deterrent effect. Where offenders are observed, charges will be proceeded with.
