COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

WORK INVESTIGATIONS/INCIDENTS DURING 2ND QUARTER INCLUDED:

A 24 yr. old male was found by his friend in a local parking lot after apparently having instigated a fight with two unknown assailants. He had been stabbed. Subject died shortly after being taken to hospital. Persons responsible have not been identified to date. Case continues under investigation.

There were three robberies of financial institutions during the quarter, two of which are solved and charges laid. One youth responsible for ten robberies of small stores between February/May in the Sperling/Hastings area has been charged.

After lengthy investigation, 2 males in early 20's were found responsible for eighty (80) break, Enter and Thefts of residential and commercial establishments and are presently before the courts. Another male has been found responsible for twelve (12) commercial and thirty (30) residential break-ins over the past six months. He is presently before the courts.

There were four (4) traffic deaths this period:

- 1) An early morning M.V. accident claimed the life of a 25-yr. old female in April, when the driver of her vehicle turned left in front of an oncoming vehicle.
- 2) Early in May a lone male driver, age 56 was killed, when the pick-up he was driving struck a parked vehicle.
- 3) In late June a 25-yr. old male pedestrian was struck and killed while walking on the side of the road. Charges pending.
- 4) On the same date in June, a head-on collision caused the death of a 77-yr. old male, when an on-coming vehicle crossed the centre line. Driver of offending vehicle remains in critical condition in hospital. Charges are pending.

Total M.V. accidents reported to date this year are slightly down (3,319 vs. 3,414) over same period last year, with personal injuries and property damage running reasonably parallel to last year.
