Your Committee would report as follows;

43.	<u>Burnaby Information & Community Society</u>	\$500.

This application was reported to Council on 1984 November 05 with the recommendation that since the Society had received an increased grant this year, Council not approve the additional request for assistance with the cost of producing 100 directories.

The application has been returned by His Worship, The Mayor, for further consideration as he was of the opinion that the additional request should be considered as a "publicity" item, in line with the publicity part of our Committee.

In reconsidering the application, additional information revealed that the Directory had been completed and the first printing already sold out. A grant of \$500. is now being requested to publish a second printing. Your Committee would now, by a majority vote, recommend that \$500. be granted to the Burnaby Information & Community Society to assist with the second printing of their new Directory.

This Society has already received a grant of \$4,000. but due to rising prices of gas, and additional services due to the bus strike, they are in bad shape, and have requested a grant of \$1,000.

Your Committee would recommend that a further grant in the amount of \$600. be awarded to the Society for 1984.

Recommendation

25. Burnaby Multicultural Society \$2,000.

This application was reported to Council on 1984 July 09 with the recommendation that as this was a "new" application, no grant be given. However, a further submission was received by Council on 1984 September 10 under Correspondence Item (e), and a renewed request was received by your Committee on 1984 October 24.

Your Committee has reconsidered the request of this Society and by a majority vote, would now recommend to Council that a "start-up" grant in the amount of \$2,000. be approved

31. St. John's Ambulance \$1,500.

This application was reported to Council on 1984 July 09 with a "nil" recommendation. Further contact has been made with the organization for specific information concerning their request. It is now submitted that their previous communication should have stated that their request was not solely for their involvement in the Summer Games, but that \$3,000. was needed to update their Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation equipment.

In the light of this new information, your Committee would now recommend that \$1,500. be given to this organization towards the cost of updating their Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation equipment.

46. Burnaby Arts Council \$2,000.

Your Committee received a request from the Burnaby Arts Council for assistance in the amount of \$3,000. to cover losses suffered on account of bad weather and the bus strike with respect to their outdoor Crafts Market. Your Committee feels that this is a responsible Burnaby organization and would therefore recommend that Council approve a grant in the amount of \$2,000. to help meet their costs for 1984.
