REPORT:

Appearing on Council's Agenda for the 1984 December 03 meeting is correspondence from Mrs. Dawne Shong of 1480 East 59th Avenue in Vancouver.

Mrs. Shong in her correspondence has made reference to the intersection of Boundary Road and Canada Way (the exit from the 401 Freeway). As this description is misleading we phoned Mrs. Shong and she advised that the intersection was, in fact, Boundary Road and Grandview Highway.

We advised Mrs. Shong that there were actually three jurisdictions at this intersection, Burnaby, the Provincial Government, and the City of Vancouver. We did point out to her though that her suggestion would be unworkable as the intersection at this time is over capacity and that her proposal would only compound the congestion. In fact, during the peak periods left turns are prohibited from the Grandview leg.

We suggested to her that she should use the Willingdon Avenue interchange and proceed via Canada Way or some other east/west route such as Moscrop or Kingsway. In the future she could go south to Imperial Street which is a more direct route to her home.

Mrs. Shong thanked us for the call and said she would try the alternate routes.
