

REPORT

Appearing on this agenda under correspondence is a letter from Mr. P.J. Larkin, City Clerk, City of New Westminster, and an attached letter from Mr. F.B. Norman, a New Westminster resident, regarding concerns about the construction standards for bicycle paths on the B.C. Parkway. These concerns are shared by Burnaby staff.

As part of the working process, we have already discussed these concerns with the President of the B.C. Cycling Association and B.C. Transit staff and their Landscape Consultants, Pavelek & Associates.

The final design will ensure maximum conformance possible with accepted standards and minimization of the conflicts referred to. B.C. Transit and their Landscape Consultants are both sensitive to the issues raised.
