52.	<u>Elderly Citizens' Bus Service</u> A grant of \$1,000. from the 1982 Budget was approved by Council for the purpose of starting a fund-raising campaign to meet the cost of continuing the Elderly Citizens' Bus Service in 1983. Your Committee would once again recommend that Council approve a grant from the 1983 Budget in the amount of \$1,000. to start up a similar fund-raising campaign for "outings for the elderly" in 1984.	\$1,000.

53.	<u>Burnaby Chamber of Commerce Tourist Centre</u> Council is aware of the benefits already being derived by the municipality from the new Tourist Centre located at 6525 Spratt Street. It is reported that the number of enquiries from out of town visitors is growing daily. Your Committee would recommend that a one time grant from the 1983 Budget in the amount of \$1,000. be approved to aid the Burnaby Chamber of Commerce in retiring their building debt or to beautify the Tourist Office.	\$1,000.
