REPORT:

The Engineering Department received a verbal request on 1984 April 05 from Captain G. Swaddling of the Salvation Army to conduct a parade from Confederation Park to their Citadel on the southeast corner of Hastings Street and Carleton Avenue at 14:45 h on Sunday, 1984 April 15. Because of time limitations we are processing this request without the normal written application. The parade is to be composed of approximately 150 marching boy scouts, cubs, girl guides, and brownies with an accompanying band. They will form up at Confederation Park and enter Willingdon Avenue at Pandora Street, proceed south on Willingdon Avenue to Hastings Street, then west on Hastings Street to the Citadel.

The Ministry of Transportation and Highways has been advised of the proposed parade and have no objections.

The R.C.M.P. are also aware of the proposed parade and will have personnel on hand to assist if required.
