
REPORT

Appearing on the Council Agenda for the 1984 October 09 meeting is a report from the Director Recreation and Cultural Services dealing with the motion passed 1984 October 03 by the Parks and Recreation Commission, with respect to the extension of Central Boulevard across the southern flank of Bonsor Park.

This Department is presently preparing a report on the subject for presentation to Council at the next Council meeting. The report will include an outline of the road as contained in the adopted Conceptual Plan, the alternatives that were considered in the process prior to recommendations and the decision being made, and a discussion of the possibilities that could be pursued should Council determine that additional land area should be included in the park in order to compensate for the boundary adjustments necessitated by the road plan.

The report will be submitted for consideration at the Council meeting of 1984 October 15. This is for the information of Council.
