60-21-054 Replace existing 4 inch water mains on Morley Drive, Ridge Drive, Belcarra Drive, Sierra Drive, Malibu Drive, and Northcliff Crescent.
CHARGE: 1985 Capital Budget - Code 60-21 Mains, Pumping Stations \$238,000
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: There is a need to replace some older undersized mains which have been experiencing leaks and other operational problems in recent years; they should also be increased in size in order to provide better fire protection. Funds are provided in the 1985 Capital Budget under Code 60-21, Mains, Pumping Stations.

60-21-052 Willingdon Avenue, Loughheed Highway to Venables Street. Replace 18 inch water main.
CHARGE: 1985 Capital Budget - Code 60-21 Mains, Pumping Stations 220,000
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: An 18 inch diameter water main on Willingdon Avenue is beyond its economic life and is giving maintenance problems. This main replacement is being funded in part by the Provincial Government Revenue Sharing Program for sewer and water projects. Funds are provided in the 1985 Capital Budget under Code 60-21, Mains, Pumping Stations.

60-21-053

Canada Way, Willingdon Avenue to Westminster Avenue. Replace 18 inch water main.

CHARGE: 1985 Capital Budget - Code 60-21 Mains, Pumping Stations \$145,000

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: An 18 inch diameter water main on Canada Way is beyond its economic life and is giving maintenance problems. This main replacement is being funded in part by the Provincial Government Revenue Sharing Program for sewer and water projects. Funds are provided in the 1985 Capital Budget under Code 60-21, Mains, Pumping Stations.

60-70-154

Stride Avenue Disposal Area. Rehabilitate Disposal Area.

CHARGE: 1985 Capital Budget - Code 70 Land Assembly & Development 60,000

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Rehabilitation of Disposal Area to conform to long range plan for the area, including filling, grading, and shaping work.

60-30-050

Implementation of Sanitary Sewer Pump Stations Study.

CHARGE: 1985 Capital Budget - Code 60-30 Sanitary Extensions 50,000

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This work forms part of a continuing and staged program to implement the recommendations of the Sewage Lift Station Study undertaken on behalf of the Corporation in 1984. The work will cover mechanical and electrical rehabilitation within the stations and minor work outside the stations. Funds are provided in the 1985 Capital Budget under Code 60-30, Sanitary Extensions.

60-30-049

Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Program. Various locations.

Charge: 1985 Capital Budget - Code 60-30 Sanitary Extensions 25,000

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This work forms part of a continuing program of sewer main rehabilitation program including such items as joint scaling, T.V. inspection, and manhole rung replacement. Funds are provided in the 1985 Capital Budget under Code 60-30, Sanitary Sewer Extensions.
