Madam And Gentlemen:


On 1984 August 20, a letter was received by Council from Mayor Toshiyuki Wanibuchi extending an invitation for a delegation from Burnaby to visit Kushiro in 1985 for the purpose of renewing the Sister City Agreement to commemorate the 20th Anniversary of our relationship. The following motion was passed by Council at that time:

"THAT Council accept the invitation as extended by the Mayor of Kushiro City, on behalf of the citizens of Kushiro, for a delegation from Burnaby to visit Burnaby's Sister City during 1985 August in recognition of the 20th Anniversary of the Sister City relationship, and further; THAT His Worship, Mayor Lewarne, bring forward a report respecting this matter."

As Council is already aware, arrangements are now well in hand and a delegation of thirty-three (33), which includes seven Aldermen and myself, will be leaving for Kushiro on Thursday, August 15th.

It is now recommended that the related expenditures be authorized by Council. For your information, provision has been made in the budget for these expenses under Code Nos. 40 00001 0004 and 40 00001 0009.
