REPORT:

Appearing on the Agenda for the regular Council Meeting of 1985 September 09 was a letter from Mr. S. McMinn, P. Eng., General Manager, Continental Environmental Systems Ltd. outlining a request for proposal for a balefill site for Lower Mainland Municipal refuse. The proposal is a general request distributed to all Municipal and Regional Governments within a 400 km. radius of the Lower Mainland.


We have discussed the proposal with Mr. McMinn and further to our discussion we should point out that his company is not necessarily requesting a dumping site in Burnaby but would be interested in obtaining an industrial balefill site in the Lower Mainland where incoming refuse would be compressed and baled and the bales transported to other areas for disposal.

While we find the proposal from Continental Environmental Systems Ltd. of interest and agree that it may be technically feasible and economically viable for certain parts of the Province of British Columbia, we would state that Burnaby is already a major and integral part of the Lower Mainland Refuse Project which is being developed at the Regional level.

We would recommend that the matter be dealt with at the Regional level especially since we understand from discussions with Mr. McMinn and G.V.R.D. staff that the latter are fully conversant with the proposal from Continental Environmental Systems Ltd.
