1. The matter was reviewed by the R.C.M.P. with some of the concerned residents and an examination was made on site.
2. The Burnaby Detachment R.C.M.P. recognizes that a parking problem exists on weekends, basically as outlined to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby on 85 MAY 13 by Mr. L.S. HODGKINS, et al.
3. The Burnaby Detachment R.C.M.P. is responding to individual complaints from the residents in that area and will continue enforcing the applicable parking bylaws, where it has been established that illegal parking is evident.
